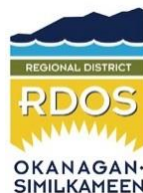

Canada 150 Mural Mosaic: The Municipality of Oliver has won a grant to create a community mural as part of a Canada-wide celebration. An iconic image has been selected, and will be designed in 600 3" x 3" mosaic tiles, with each tile colour-graded. At community workshops (May 30 – June 1), locals of all ages and skill levels will be invited to paint their own tile (in an image of their choosing, as long as it is within the colours graded for that tile). All the tiles will be fitted together into one 8' x 12' mural and the overall image will be unveiled later in the summer. OCAC members will be especially welcome to participate.
