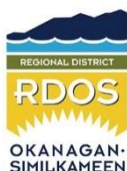

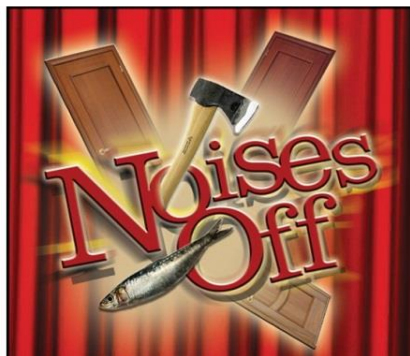
January is a new year for **OCAC Membership**. Show your support for local arts by renewing. The form is available on our website under "Membership".

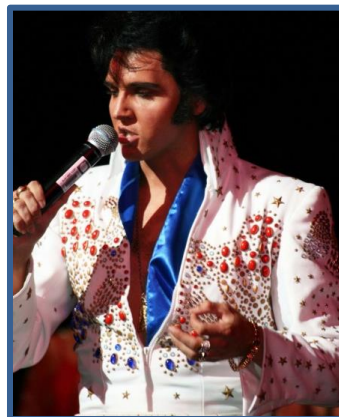
