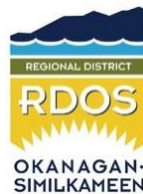

Winners All! The arts council awarded a record **nine** Contracted Service Agreements at its June meeting of the Board. First, treasurer Arleyene Farnworth moved releasing up to \$4500 in contracts, and the Board determined that all applications had meritorious programming deserving of funding, as well as many applications that demonstrated clear financial need. All proposed events met the criteria of the OCAC constitutional mandate: providing public, accessible, artistic events or educational workshops.



The contracts are: *Desert Sage Spinners and Weavers* (workshop), *Friends of the Oliver Library* (Summer Reading Program children's art project), *Musaic Vocal Ensemble* (concert), *Oliver Community Garden Society* (two workshops), *RipOff Artists* (10th anniversary exhibit, sale & demonstration), *Sage Valley Voices* (concert), *South Okanagan Amateur Players* (theatre), *South Okanagan Concert Society* (concert series). A contract was also awarded for the Agnes Sutherland Memorial event "*The Sound of Colour*". This exhibit, sale and reception will raise funds for a piano in the Frank Venables Theatre lobby.

Arts & Music Funding for the Schools: In memory of Agnes Sutherland, the arts council made five donations of \$1000 apiece to arts and music programs in local schools. These donations were made possible from the proceeds of the Michael Burgess concert, which had been accumulating in a term deposit designated for educational purposes. All funding is for capital purchases not covered by school budgets, such as musical instruments, digital systems, sheet music, art equipment and tools. The board approved teachers' wish lists including: SOSS Musical Futures, SOSS Art Department, Tuc-el-Nuit Mindfulness Centre (art therapy), Tuc-el-Nuit art and music programs, and the Oliver Elementary music program.

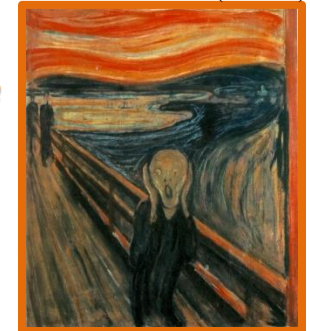
