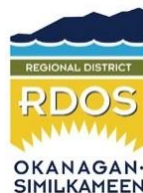

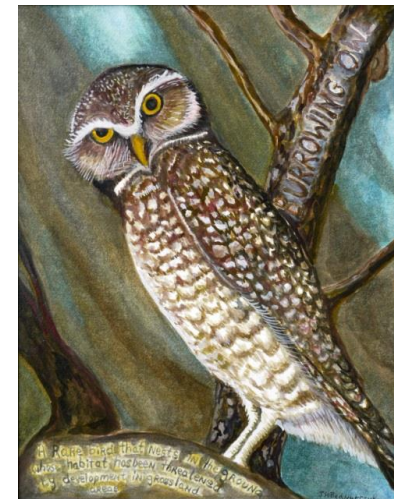
Arts Council News

Money Wise: The recent AGM was full of good news. The year-end external review of financials gave the OCAC a very high rating. The membership applauded the work of Treasurer Arleyene Farnworth as she steps down after five years. She continues as the council's bookkeeper. In addition, the arts council has recently been awarded annual operational funding from the BC Arts Council, totalling \$13,125. This combines three portions: a basic amount (\$2000), a local government matching amount (\$4000), and the annual performance award (\$7125). This is the most the OCAC has received.

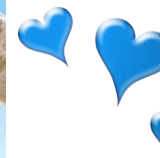
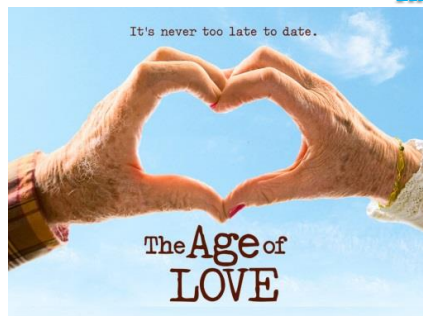
