- 1 All artwork and photography should be based on the theme.
- 2 All exhibits to be made or grown by the exhibitor
- 3 One entry only per exhibitor in any category.  
*note: only one exhibitor's name per exhibitor tag*
- 4 Exhibitors tags can be picked up at the Oliver Parks and Recreation Office the week prior to the festival during the hours of 9 am and 4 pm.
- 5 All exhibits to be brought to the Community Hall between 5pm and 8pm on Friday, August 17
- 6 Exhibitors are responsible for filling out their own tags and attaching them to their exhibit.
- 7 Exhibits will be placed in the main hall by the Fair Committee.
- 8 Paper plates will be provided by the Fair for the display of fruits, vegetables and baking.
- 9 Baking must be enclosed in a new clear plastic bag.
- 10 The Fair Committee will safe exhibits as much as possible, but will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage.
- 11 Prizes will be awarded by the Judge's decision and is final.
